Our core purpose is to enrich lives by building the American Dream.

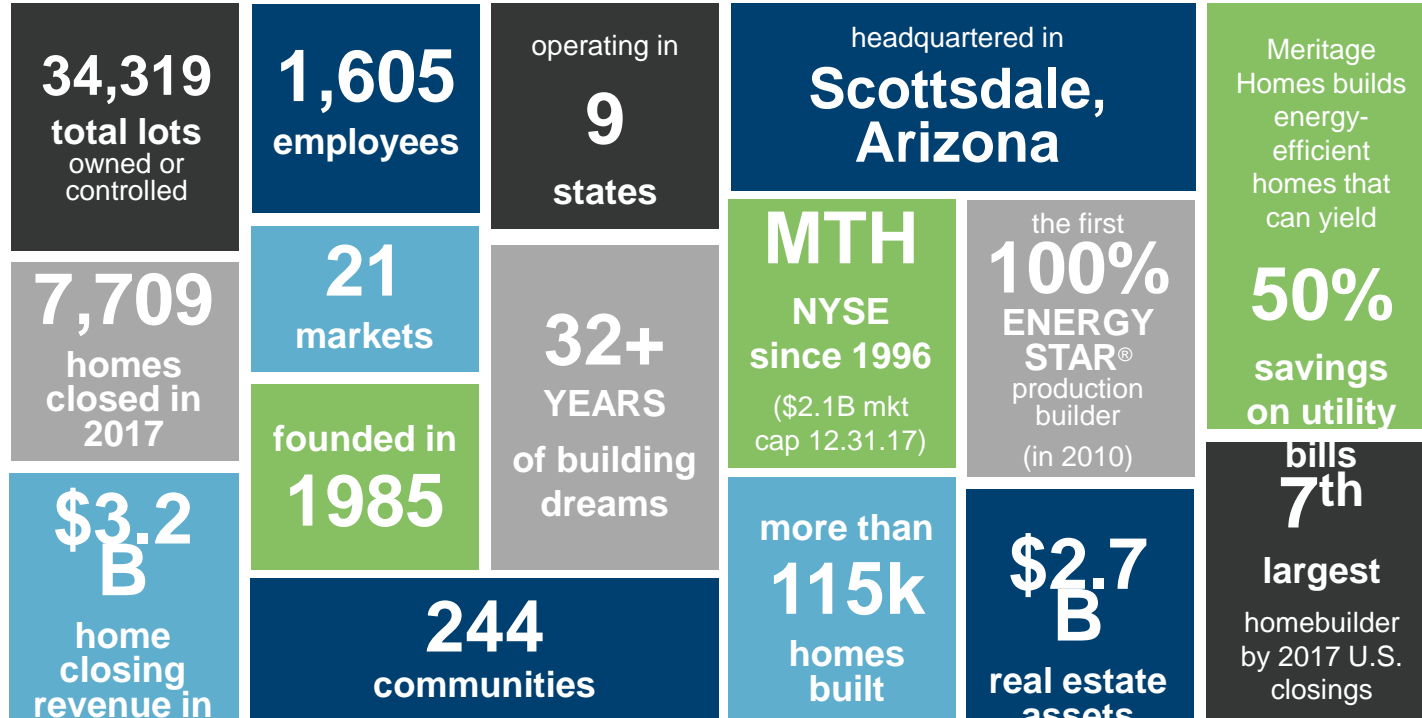

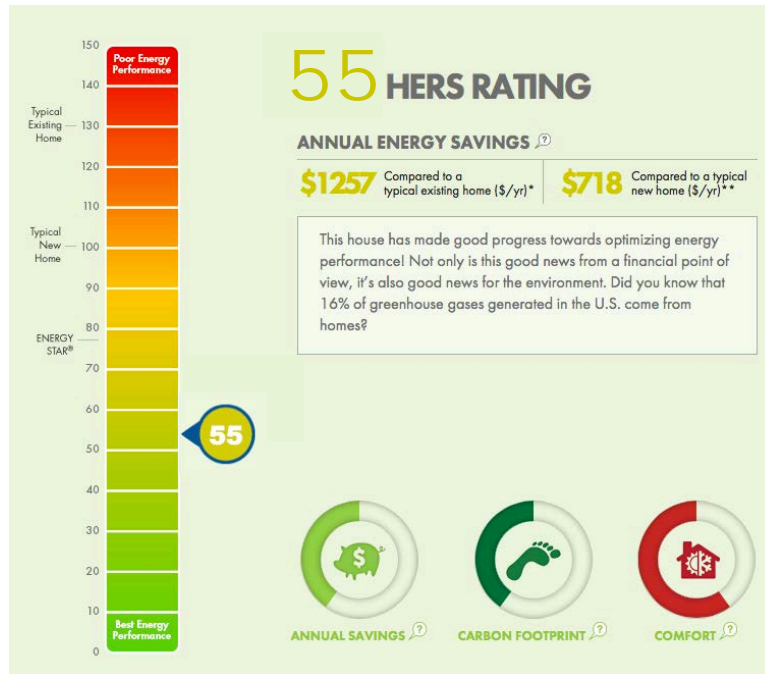

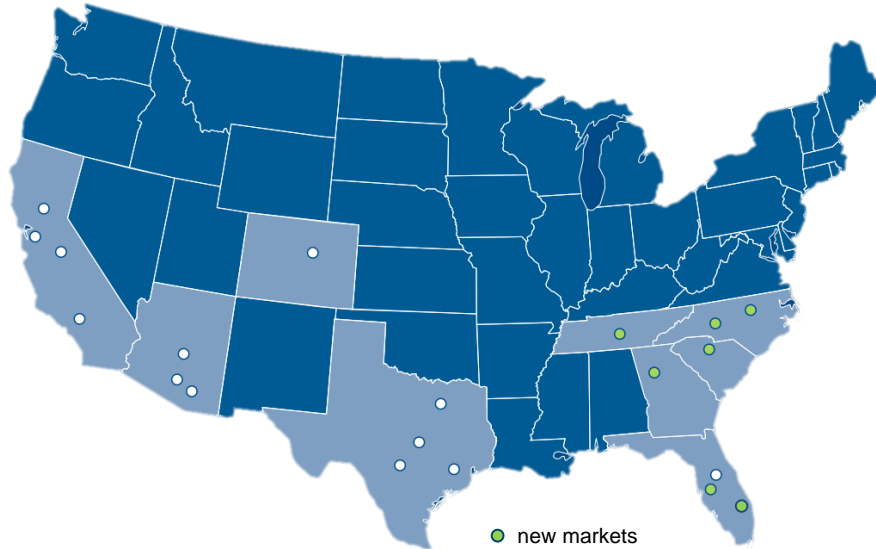
